

TT MEDITERRANEAN RECORD NETWORK

Terms and Conditions The 20th of February 2025

1. General Overview

TT Record Networks (hereinafter "TT Record Networks") is a speed record activity offered by Thomas Tison Yacht Design & Engineering EURL. It facilitates the recognition and certification of sailing speed records within the Mediterranean Sea, operating as part of the company's broader activities in yacht design and maritime innovation. By participating in TT Record Networks, the skipper and crew (hereinafter "Participant") acknowledge and accept full responsibility for their participation and agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.

2. Registration Process

To participate in TT Record Networks and attempt a record, the following steps must be completed:

- 2.1 Online Registration: The Participant must create an account on the official TT Record Networks website and provide personal and vessel details.
- 2.2 Payment and Acceptance: The registration fee of XX euros per record attempt must be paid through our secure payment gateway. Only upon successful payment and acceptance of these terms will the Participant's registration be considered complete, and they will be officially entered into the record attempt.
- 2.3 Age Requirement: The skipper must be at least 18 years of age to register and participate in TT Record Networks.

3. Eligible Boats and Records

3.1 Eligible Boats: Eligible boats include classic yachts designed before 1950, foiling boats, and yachts designed by Thomas Tison Yacht Design SARL.

- 3.2 Record Routes: Upon registration, the Participant must choose one of the following records:
 - Monaco to Mahon Record
 - Monaco to St Tropez Record
 - Monaco to Calvi Record
 - Monaco to Portofino Record

The Participant acknowledges that records may be attempted in one direction or the reverse, and both attempts will be considered valid as long as they meet the requirements for the record.

3.3 Start and Finish Lines:

The start and finish lines for each record route are defined by two buoy coordinates (Virtual Buoy 1 and Virtual Buoy 2) for each end of the route. Participants must use their own device, such as a smartphone, and download the approved tracking app from the TT Record Networks website. This app will record their attempt as they pass through the lines, ensuring the attempt is accurately logged from start to finish.

- 3.4 Categories: Records will be categorized according to classic yachts, foiling yachts, and all others according to TT Record Networks' own real or corrected time.

4. Conducting a Record Attempt

- 4.1 GPS Tracking: The Participant must use an approved GPS tracking application downloaded from the TT Record Networks website. The GPS log must start before the start line and stop after the finish line. The use of the GPS tracking app is at the full responsibility of the skipper and crew, and TT Record Networks holds no liability for any failure, use, or associated issues in the tracking or the app.
- 4.2 Safety Compliance: The Participant acknowledges that all vessels attempting a speed record must meet applicable maritime regulations and safety standards, including with regards to design category and safety equipment on board. The responsibility for ensuring compliance with these regulations rests solely with the Participant.
- 4.3 Weather and Risk Management: The Participant is solely responsible for assessing and accepting risks associated with weather conditions and sea state during the attempt. TT Record Networks encourages Participants to check weather conditions with meteorological services before attempting the record.
- 4.4 Time and Date Selection: The timing of the record attempt is at the sole discretion of the skipper.

5. Completion and Submission

- 5.1 GPS Track Upload: The Participant must upload the GPS track file via the TT Record Networks website within 15 days of completing their record attempt. Failure to submit within this time frame may result in the disqualification of the attempt.
- 5.2 Additional Information: The Participant may be required to submit supplementary details, including but not limited to boat logs, photographic or video evidence, and crew declarations. Note that additional information will only be requested in extreme circumstances or events requiring additional clarification.
- 5.3 Verification and Certification: TT Record Networks will review the submitted data to verify the attempt's validity. If approved, the record will be officially recognized and published on the TT Record Networks platform.
- 5.4 Cancelled Attempts: If an attempt is canceled, the Participant must still submit their GPS track and any relevant data. All attempts, including canceled attempts, will be listed on the official TT Record Networks leaderboard.

6. Transfer of Responsibility

- 6.1 Skipper's Responsibility: The Participant, particularly the skipper, assumes full responsibility for the vessel, the crew, and all associated risks. This includes, but is not limited to, decisions regarding vessel safety, weather conditions, and crew welfare and training before, during, and after the record attempt.
- 6.2 Liability Waiver: The Participant acknowledges that TT Record Networks is a facilitator of record attempts and holds no liability for accidents, injuries, damages, or legal consequences arising from participation, including indirect or consequential damages. Participants may not claim damages, losses, or compensation from TT Record Networks in the event of disqualification or any other cause.

7. Sportsmanship and Fair Play

7.1 Code of Conduct: TT Record Networks is created as a game and should be taken as such. Participants are expected to compete in the spirit of sportsmanship, honesty, and

respect for fellow sailors. No source of propulsion force other than the wind is allowed; all boats must be capable of floating statically in the water.

- 7.2 Fair Play: Any deliberate attempt to gain an unfair advantage, manipulate data, or violate the spirit of competition will result in disqualification.
- 7.3 Dispute Resolution: In the event of any disputes regarding eligibility or violations of fair play, Participants may appeal to TT Record Networks. TT Record Networks will review all relevant information, and the final decision will be made by TT Record Networks. All decisions will be final.
- 7.4 Disqualification: In case of a dispute regarding eligibility or violation of fair play, including potential disqualification, the record attempt will not be listed, and the registration fee will be retained by TT Record Networks.

8. Data Usage and Privacy

- 8.1 Consent: By registering for TT Record Networks, the Participant agrees to the collection, storage, and use of their personal and sailing data for the purposes of record verification, publication, and related activities. TT Record Networks will adhere to applicable data protection laws, including GDPR, where applicable.
- 8.2 Public Disclosure: Participants acknowledge that record attempts, including their name, vessel details, and GPS track, will be published on the TT Record Networks platform and associated media. Participants are not allowed to opt out of having their record published.
- 8.3 Data Retention and Sharing: Participant data will be retained for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in these Terms and Conditions. TT Record Networks will not share Participant data with third parties without explicit consent, except as required by law.
- 8.4 Marketing Usage: TT Record Networks may also use the Participant's name, vessel information, and images from the event for promotional or marketing purposes, including social media or media campaigns.

9. Amendments and Modifications

TT Record Networks reserves the right to modify these Terms and Conditions at any time. Significant changes will be communicated to Participants via email or through website notifications at least 14 days before they take effect.
